This very special pencil, made with Cumberland graphite from the original and unique Borrowdale mine, features a stunning white gold and diamond pencil crown; designed exclusively by Daniela Paladi and handmade by Mario Pietroluongo for Derwent to commemorate Her Majesty The Queen's Diamond Jubilee in June 2012.

The pencil crown displays three very distinctive features; the gold lilies to symbolise royalty, the shape derives from that of the diamond and the 60 encrusted diamonds sparkle with reflected light, 1 for each year of Her Majesty's glorious reign.

Only 2 of these exclusive pencils have been made; one of which will be presented to Her Majesty The Queen and the other will remain on display in The Pencil Museum, Keswick for all to see.
